

584-020-0035 The ethical educator is a person who accepts the requirements of membership in the teaching profession and conducts professional duties at all times in ethical ways. In so doing, the ethical educator considers the needs of the students, the district, and the community.

1. The ethical educator, in fulfilling obligations to the student, will:

(a) Adhere to the conditions of a contract or the terms of the appointment

(b) Conduct professional business, including grievances, through established lawful and reasonable procedures

(c) Strive for continued improvement and professional growth

(d) Accept no gratuities or gifts of significance that could influence judgment in the exercise of professional duties

(e) Not use the district's or school's name, property, or resources for non-educational benefit without approval of the ethical educator's supervisor or the appointing authority

2. The ethical educator, in fulfilling obligations to the profession, will:

(a)

(d) Exercise professional duties in a manner that maintains the integrity of the profession and the public trust
