

Laundry Guidelines

Keep laundry loads to $\frac{1}{2}$ the height of the machine's interior tub. (More clothes than that and clothes won't get clean and/or may disappear.)



Proper loading will result in a complete cycle, providing thorough agitation, cleaning and rinsing, plus an effective spin to remove excess water before drying.

Use the correct amount of detergent. If you use too much soap, the machine will overflow and clothes may feel itchy.

One pod works for most loads, or $\frac{1}{2}$ the lid cup of a liquid detergent bottle. Check the measurement instructions on your laundry detergent for the best amount to use.

Empty the dryer's lint trap before use for proper air flow and for the most effective drying cycle.

The washing machines and dryers are serviced by a contracted company (Coin Meter). Let Residence Life know if a machine is not operating correctly so that they can report and track the service need.
